## What is the remote learning guide?

Where students are unable to attend school due to, medical, or disciplinary reasons we will continue to provide resources to enable students to continue their education at home – we call this remote learning. We want to minimise the impact to your child's education and therefore we have a plan to make sure learning can continue, when they are unable to attend school.

We will be providing all teaching resources through Microsoft Teams. All students will be automatically placed in a Team for their classes in all subjects. Teachers will place all activities, including lessons and resources as files in these Teams. Pupils can access the Teams through their school email accounts. Teachers will also set homework and send messages to their pupils using MS Teams. All work will be available before the lesson is due to start.

You can see a summary of what is being taught each week through the remote learning guides that are shared on the school website every Friday. Pupils can access the guides using FROG. Your child's teachers, will also be available via email to answer any questions or queries your child may have. The email address for the head of each department is also included within this guide if you need to contact them regarding any subject related issue.

### What is your child learning this term?

This term pupils will be looking at literature from around the world in ‘Seminal World Literature.’ Pupils will analyse how a writer defines culture in a text and respond to language devices and features used for effect. Their assessment will involve them writing a letter as a character from one of the texts/extracts they will study.

This will then be followed by Shakespeare’s Tragedies; pupils will study either Macbeth or Romeo and Juliet. They will read the opening acts of the chosen play for them and ensure they have a solid understanding of the characters and themes Shakespeare demonstrates.

### What is your child learning this term?

This term pupils in Year 9 will study Timeless Tales of the Victorian era focusing on Oliver Twist. They will gain an understanding of the context of the time, looking at the use of workhouses and the class divide between the wealthy and poor. Pupils will write a letter as Oliver from a key moment in the novel.

This will be followed by Shakespeare's tragedies with the pupils starting their study of Literature on Romeo and Juliet. Pupils will read the first act of the play and ensure they have a clear understanding of the characters, plot and themes, as well as begin to understand the language used by Shakespeare for effect.
