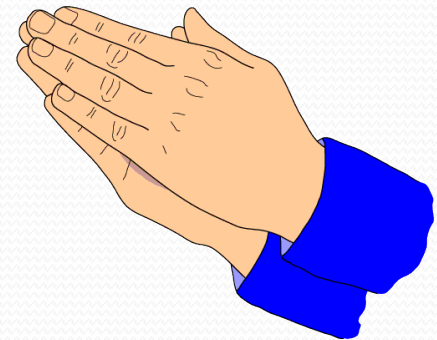
# Curriculum

## RE

- Across the year, we will be teaching 6 RE topics.

### **Autumn - Celebrating the Mass, From Advent to Christmas**

- In addition to our R.E. curriculum, we pray together three times a day and take part in assemblies, masses and liturgies throughout the year. Pupils also regularly plan and lead acts of collective worship in their classes.

  - 6F –25<sup>th</sup> November @ 9am



# Curriculum

- **English** – Writing and grammar is taught through a range of genres such as: non-fiction, narrative and poetry.

To write with purpose	To use imaginative description	To organise appropriately
To use paragraphs	To use sentences appropriately	To present neatly
To spell correctly	To punctuate accurately	To analyse writing

- Reading Practice sessions will take place once a week in class.
- The key skills in reading are: 'To read words accurately' and 'To understand texts.'
- We expect Year 6 children to read daily in school and at home, including reading aloud to an adult.
- Parents sign reading records 5 times a week.
- Recommended reading list on school website.

# Curriculum

- **Maths** – We follow the 'White Rose' scheme of learning; teaching the following skills:

To know and use numbers	To use fractions	To use statistics
To add and subtract	To understand the properties of shapes	To use algebra
To multiply and divide	To describe position, direction and movement	To use measures

- Each unit builds on prior learning and homework is set to consolidate the children's learning.

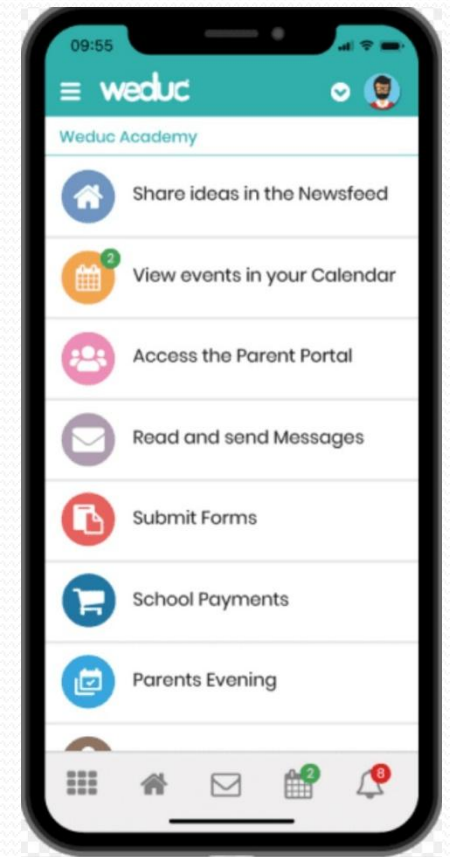
