



# Religious Education Long Term Plan

Pocklington Infants follows the ERYC Agreed Syllabus and Understanding Christianity to teach Religion and World Views. RE is not a statutory subject for Nursery and Reception but as a faith based school we have chosen to teach RE following the guidance contained in the ERYC RE in the Early Years Foundation stage document. We teach Christianity, Islam and Judaism across the school. Some units are specific to a religion, others are thematic and cover several religions.
