We are always on the look out for more donations.

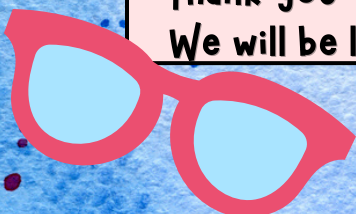
Any unwanted toys or larger loose parts are always gratefully received. As you can imagine many toys do end up in our toy hospital!

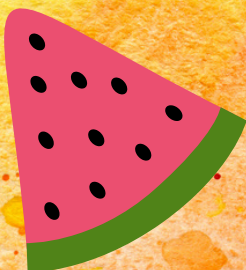
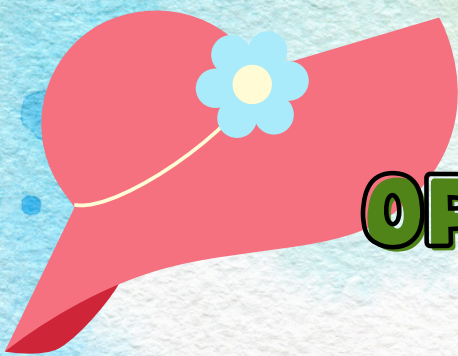
Wellies

Thank you to the OPAL playrangers for giving up their time to help. We will be looking to add to our team next year.

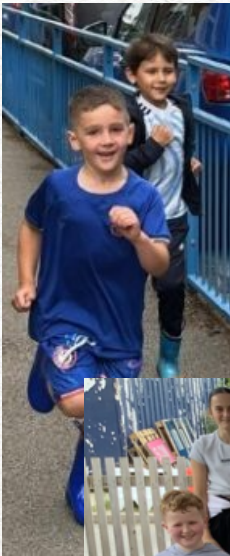


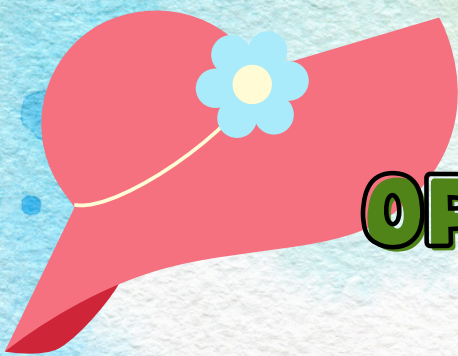

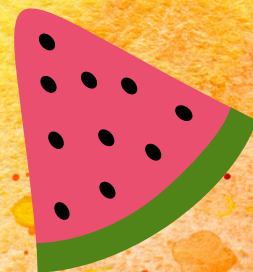
