

# Year 2 Autumn Term 2025-26



Our Themes for the Autumn Term are:  
**“Roald Dahl” and “The Nativity”**

RE: Our units this term are:

‘Celebrating the Mass’ and ‘From Advent to Christmas.’

Each class will be hosting their own Nativity assembly:

2D – Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December

2K – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December

2SO – Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December

English: We read a range of texts including:

-How to Catch a Star

-The Twits and other Roald Dahl classics

-The Jolly Christmas Postman

In English the children will learn to write using the correct grip, posture and formation, to use capital letters and full stops correctly, to use conjunctions and connectives and begin to use more advanced punctuation.

**Grammar Skills:** To know what a noun, adjective and verb is and identify these in sentences. To identify an exclamation and question mark and use these sentence types in their writing.

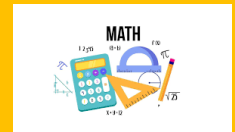
**Reading Skills:** To read words accurately and to understand texts. To use a range of strategies to work out unfamiliar words.



**Remember to keep up your reading – a minimum of 15 minutes a night.**

**Maths:** This term we will be mainly focusing on the skills of-

- Recognising the place value of each digit in a 2 and 3-digit number (hundreds, tens and ones)
- Using place value and number facts to solve problems.
- Compare and order numbers from 0-100 using < > and = signs.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to fluently (number bonds – 10/20/100)
- Written addition and Written subtraction methods.



## Geography

‘UK’

We will be looking at using observational and map skills to identify the geography of the UK and the human and physical features of different areas.



## Science – Animals including Humans

We will be learning about how humans have offspring, the basic needs for survival, the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

### RSHE

Children will be discussing and learning about the Zones of Regulation, British Values and lessons focusing on well-being and managing emotions.

### Physical Education

Throughout the term children will take part in outdoor games with a focus on special awareness and ball skills. In indoor PE, the focus will be on yoga and fitness and team building.



### Computing

Our topics this term are 'What is IT?' and 'Photography.' We will be looking about what IT stands for and where can we see IT in our everyday lives.



### Art and D&T

Children will build on their drawing (telling a story) and painting skills. We will also be looking at colour mixing.

We will be making mini chairs and moving monsters.
