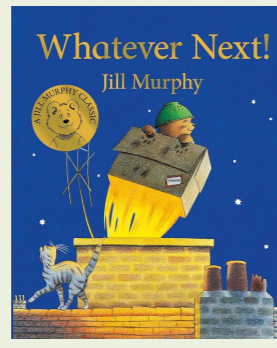

Children will:

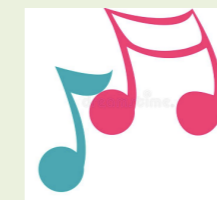
- Know who they can talk to if they experience any problems
