Ummah	A Muslim community.
Tawhid	The oneness of God. He is One and there is no other God.
Calligraphy	Decorative handwriting.
Pilgrimage	A journey taken by religious followers to show their faith.
Qu'ran	A Holy Scripture followed by Muslims.
Hafiz/Hafiza	People who memorise the Qur'an.
Prophet	A person regarded as a teacher or proclaimer of the will of God.
