What are the expectations for planning? Is there a set format?

Weekly Art Sessions Are taught in Key Stage 1 and depending on the topic it could be an Art Week or 1 lesson Per week for a half term.

Art is planned from the learning ladders based upon the national Curriculum.
Long Term Plans are used to create weekly lessons.

In Key Stage 2, Art is taught by an Art Teacher who has been appointed through the school. Key Stage 2 have a weekly art session.

Planning is informed by

- The National Curriculum
- Ignite topics
- Important dates/events on the calendar e.g. Eid, bonfire night, Chinese New Year, the different seasons, remembrance day etc.

What are the expectations for assessment? When are assessments due?

Currently there is no set format to assess Art.
The Sketchbooks move up with pupils and show the progression currently.

What are the expectations for marking?

Each piece of work is to be assessed – however it is down to the teacher's autonomy to find an appropriate method to provide feedback as instantly as possible for the children with clear next steps

Some methods may include but are not limited to:

- Peer assessment
- Self assessment

Use of marking codes to reduce teacher workload and maximise impact

Use of green pen during lessons and in the moment verbal feedback

Key stage One have a resources stock cupboard outside the year 2 area and Key Stage 2 have a stock cupboard upstairs. Stock is replenished at the end of the year. A Stock take is carried out each half term to ensure we have the resources needed to teach the art curriculum.
