

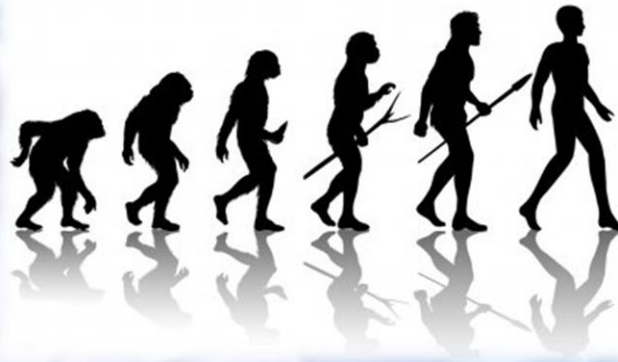

Subject Specific Vocabulary

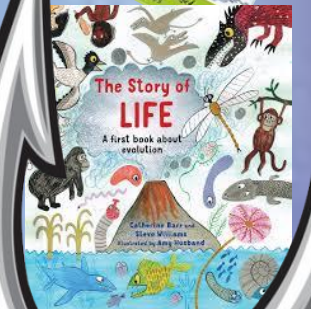
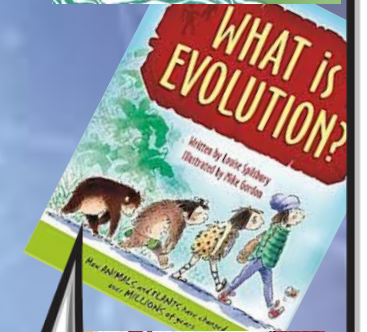
offspring	A young animal or plant that is produced by reproduction of that species
Inheritance	When characteristics are passed onto offspring from their parents
Variations	The differences between individuals within a species
Characteristics	The distinguishing features or qualities that are specific to species
Adaptation	A trait (or characteristics) changing to increase a living things chances of surviving and reproducing
Habitat	A specific are or place in which particular animals and plants can live
Environment	Contains many habitats and includes areas where there are both living and non-living things.
Adaptive traits	Genetic features that help a living thing survive
Inherited traits	These are traits that a received from parents and are often seen throughout families.



Evolution and Inheritance



- ◆ **Evolution is adaption over time and is a continuous process**
- ◆ **Traits can be inherited or adaptive**
- ◆ **Animals adapt to their environment to survive**
- ◆ **Fossils allow scientist to study evolution over time**
