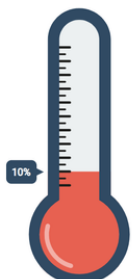
We are starting to work on our plans for Comic Relief in March, please encourage your children to share their thoughts and ideas for fundraising with their School Councillors.
