- It was wonderful to see your fantastic children this morning. We started with an assembly led by Dunham Massey focusing on blossom. On Friday, Y2-4 will have the opportunity to create a blossom flower made from clay and we are informed that all children will receive a free pass to visit Dunham Massey when the flowers created are on display in May for you to go and see.
