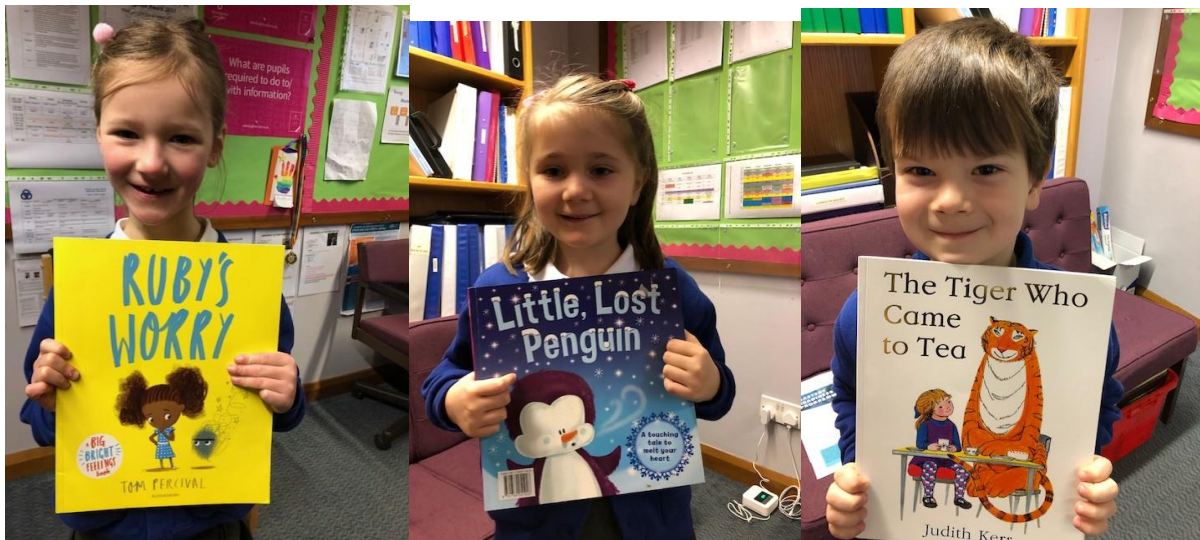
### Welcome Back
