Our EYFS

Our new, bright and spacious EYFS area has been thoughtfully designed to spark curiosity, independence and a love of learning from the very start. Children benefit from dedicated indoor and outdoor learning zones, rich continuous provision and high-quality resources that support early literacy, numeracy, creativity and play-based exploration.

Skilled Early Years practitioners carefully plan activities that nurture each child's interests, build confidence and develop essential early skills. With a strong focus on communication, early language, social interaction and physical development, our Early Years setting gives every child the best possible start. The seamless blend of structured teaching and child-led play ensures pupils feel safe, supported and excited to learn every day.

We ensure every child has a confident, happy start to school. In the summer term, nursery visits and transition sessions help children get to know us and their new setting. At the start of term, home visits strengthen relationships with families and give us valuable insight into each child. During the first weeks, we focus on helping children settle, build routines and understand their starting points, ensuring they feel secure and ready to learn.

Children are taught to recognise and name their feelings and are equipped with practical strategies to manage them. By embedding wellbeing into the curriculum and daily routines, we nurture emotionally intelligent, resilient learners who feel safe, seen and supported.

Strong Relationships with Parents and Families

We value open, positive relationships with parents and carers. Our approachable staff and family-friendly ethos ensure that every family feels part of our school community.
