

This week in Reception

Phonics:

We will revisit all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs - ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air. We will be reading and writing CVCC words including champ, chimp, chest, punch, bench, munch, shift, shelf, hunt, cost, melt, milk, shrink, crack, smash, frog, smell, swim, drink, dress, plug, bring and truck. We will be writing sentences and focusing in clear spaces between words. We will be reading and writing the 'tricky' words: **some, come, love, do.**

At home, please continue learning the 'tricky' words: said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today.

What we are learning:

In Literacy, we will be sharing the traditional tale of The Little Red Hen and focusing on retelling the story using narrative language and repetition. We will be focusing on sentence writing, characterisation and comprehension. In addition, we will be writing about our visit to Attwell farm.

In Maths, we will be building on our knowledge and understanding of number bonds including addition and subtraction facts. We will be working on finding double and half of a number. We will continue developing our familiarity of teen numbers remembering that the 1 is a ten. We will be exploring what is one more and one less than a number and using a number line.
