Locational knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Build on European knowledge whilst focusing on environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics of the countries of Europe. ● Identify land-use patterns across the counties and cities of the UK. ● Understand how land use in the UK has changed over time.
Place knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of greater Manchester and the Campania region of Italy.
Human and Physical Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography e.g. volcanoes, cliffs, mountains ● Describe and understand key aspects of human geography e.g. types of settlements and land use.
