

This week in Reception

Phonics:

In Phonics this week, we will be learning the trigraph 'air' (chair) and the digraph 'er' (digger). We will be learning to read words containing double letters - bb (rabbit), rr (carrot), gg (bigger), dd (hidden), pp (puppet), ff (toffee) and bb (ribbon). We will be revisiting the 'tricky' words: **was, they, you, my, by, all** & learning **are, sure & pure**. We will be writing: chair, fair, are, letter, hammer, sure, bigger, rabbit, pure, hidden, kitten and go.

What we are learning:

Our learning this week is based on the narratives 'Dinosaurs and all that rubbish' and 'Crunch Munch Dinosaur Lunch.' We will be discussing main events and making predictions. We will be using full sentences to talk about what we have learnt and writing a sentence by segmenting the sounds in words.

In maths, we are focusing on the pairs of number which make 8, 9 and 10 and using our language to justify why it is 8 or not 8.


