


# PENYBONT PRIMARY SCHOOL

## School Attendance

The table below identifies three sets of statistics relating to school our whole school attendance. The 'Weekly Attendance' figure shows the attendance for that week. The 'Running Attendance' shows the school's attendance percentage from September to date and for this term to date.

If the percentages are coloured red, they are below our whole school target of 93%. If they are coloured in green, they are equal to or above our 93% attendance target for the whole school.

### Attendance Update: Autumn Term (to 19 Dec 2025)

Thank you, families, for your support throughout the Autumn Term. Every day in school makes a difference, and we've seen lots to celebrate:

- **Strong start:** Our best week was the first week back (94.2% on 05 Sept) with another great week in early November (92.6% on 07 Nov).
- **Steady overall picture:** Across the term, weekly attendance averaged 91.1% (median 91.0%), with most weeks sitting around the 91–92% mark.
- **Consistency highlights:** We achieved five weeks at or above 92%. Late November and December were tougher (as often happens), and we'll use that learning to spring forward in the new term.

### Our spring goal:

Let's aim for **93%+ weekly attendance**. Little changes build big gains:

- Keep morning routines calm and consistent.
- Try to schedule appointments outside school hours where possible.
- Please let us know early if your child is unwell and return as soon as they're ready.
- Arrive on time: being present from the start of the day helps learning and confidence.

Together, we can make every day count. Thank you for everything you do—your partnership truly matters.
