Who are the key staff?

What are the expectations for planning? Is there a set format?

All planning is available on PE Passport. All members of staff have a log in for this.

What are the expectations for assessment? When are assessments due?

Assessment is three-fold.

1. Assessment on PE Passport after each unit – bronze, silver, gold or greater depth ability.
2. Low stakes end of year quiz using Kahoot (Available for each year group on the T-drive) Quiz to be performed and scores taken. (Pupil skills)
3. Teacher to complete impact summary each term relating to units taught that year.

What are the expectations for marking?

Marking is not expected, however, there is an expectation to place evidence on the T-drive such as pictures/videos. These can be found under T-Drive – Curriculum – P.E. – PE 22-23 – Evidence – Then choose the appropriate year group.

Are there any resources that are expected to be used? Where can these be found?

PE Passport, planning, Ipads, and a range of sporting equipment. Equipment is stored in the PE Garage. Mats, benches and gymnastics apparatus are stored in the Old Hall.

Where, in the school can physical resources be found?

PE specific resources are stored in the PE Garage – garage located on KS2 playground with white door
 Ipads are stored in the ICT Suite. Each class teacher also their own iPad.
 Mats, benches and gymnastics apparatus are stored in the Old Hall.
 All resources must be returned after each lesson to be made available for others to use.

How often should the subject be taught?

The subject must be taught for two hours per week.
 Preferably one hour with our sports coach (Mr Conley) and one by the class teacher or carousel teacher.
