| Voice | Point of view. |
| Message | An expression - communication of emotions, ideas and perspectives. |
| Typography | The art of arranging letters and text to provide a message. |
| Overlaid images | Adding a text or image over another image. |
| Community | A group of people with the same attitudes or interests. |
| Poster | 2D printed artwork which hangs on a wall. |
| Screen-printing | A process where ink is forced through a mesh onto a surface. |
