We are concerned that this game is not suitable for young children.



ABOUT THE GAME

'99 Nights in the Forest' is a survival game on Roblox where players must survive in a dark forest for 99 nights. The game includes scary creatures, chase scenes, jumpscare, and weapons.



This game contains frightening content that may upset or disturb young children.

AGE RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on online safety guidance and content reviews:

UNDER 6



NOT RECOMMENDED

Content is not suitable for under 6s.

AGES 7-9



SERIOUS CAUTION

Not recommended. Serious caution advised due to scary content.

AGES 10-12



PLAY TOGETHER

Parents should play alongside their child and discuss the scary features of the game.



WHY THIS IS CONCERNING



The game is not appropriate for Reception aged children.



It may cause fear, anxiety, nightmares or distress.



Children may act out scenes from the game in real life.



We have seen children acting out this game on the playground, which can be upsetting and unsafe.



PLAYGROUND IMPACT

Children have been acting out parts of the game during playtimes. This can lead to:

- Scaring or upsetting other children
- Unsafe play
- Confusion between reality and the game
- Increased worries or fears

We want all children to feel safe, happy and able to enjoy their play.



WHAT YOU CAN DO

- ✓ Check the games your child is playing on Roblox.
- ✓ Talk to your child about what they are playing and watching.
- ✓ Use parental controls and privacy settings.
- ✓ Encourage age-appropriate play and content.
- ✓ If you are unsure about a game, research it or ask for advice.
