Arithmetic

As part of the KIRFs for this half term, we are going to be revising your times tables. By the end of Year 4, you should have known all of your times table facts up to 12×12 .

For this half term, you are going to be tested all of the facts, including division and missing number problems.

You will be tested each week on 10. Example questions include:

$$2 \times 5$$

$$9 \times 5$$

$$60 \div 12$$

$$99 \div 9$$

$$2 \times _ = 18$$

$$_ \times 10 = 100$$
