This week Reverend Canon Dodie Marsden returned from her travels in Uganda and spoke to the whole school about her visit to Kyankowe, our partner school. Dodie read a lovely letter to the children from the Headteacher of Kyankowe and shared a book the children from Kyankowe had all contributed towards about the animals that they regularly see in their village. The children from Kyankowe also shared that they enjoyed looking at the book created by Kingsclere primary children about UK flora and fauna.

We have had lots of special days to support curriculum learning. On 20th November we held our Grounds Day. Luckily the sun shone, and the children extended their curriculum learning linked to Science, Geography and History. Children have also taken part in Odd Socks Day to support the importance of respecting our differences. Anti-Bullying Week recognised the importance of this year's message: 'Choose Respect'. We have also invited NSPCC



workshop leaders into the school to help children recognise the importance of safeguarding and promote the key theme to 'Speak Out. Stay Safe.' Our Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) and Relationships, Sex, Health Education (RSHE) curriculum continues to support weekly learning linked to safety and also respecting differences to support all children in becoming good citizens showing our values of love, courage and respect.





The Remembrance event in the village was such a special event and well done to our school leaders, Arya, Dan and Keely, who read poems at the memorial and in the church. All the children who lay a cross for each of the soldiers represented the school brilliantly — thank you to all

parents/carers and governors who were able to help support at the event. We also held a remembrance service at school on 11th November to recognise this important occasion.

Thank you to everyone who joined and supported our Fireworks festival and a special thank you to Mys Jayne Verney and the whole fireworks and FKS team who made this event possible. As well as being an important community event, the evening raised about £7000 which will support the school in being able to run the swimming pool in the Summer Term. Our 'Break the Rules Day', organised by our School Council, raised £329. Some of the donations the children shared have been sent to Kyankowe and some will be used for new lunchtime equipment for both playgrounds. The children have been busy writing their playtime resources wish lists!
