We are very much looking forward to welcoming families to our Carnival on Friday 27th March.

On the morning of the event, we ask that all pupils arrive at school as normal. Please ensure that the pupils wear old clothes and trainers to school for the colour run (preferably a white t-shirt). Parents & Carers will need these too if you are participating!

Easter Bonnet Parade

After pupils have been dropped off to school, parents and carers are invited to make their way directly to the school field, via Gate A, where the Easter Bonnet Parade will begin promptly at 9:15am.

Following the Easter Bonnet Parade, pupils will be ready to be collected from their classrooms at 9:45am. **Once collected, pupils remain the responsibility of their parents and carers for the remainder of the day, and cannot be handed back into the care of the school.** Any child who is not collected will continue to stay with school staff. As always, safeguarding is our highest priority, so it is essential that we know where every child is at all times. Pupils should not be left unattended.

Throughout the day, families can enjoy a wide variety of activities, workshops and performances. We hope that you make the most of this opportunity to spend time together and explore the many engaging experiences on offer.

We are also delighted to offer a range of food stalls, including freshly made hot drinks, crêpes, BBQ options, pizza, and a selection of refreshments available to purchase throughout the day. In addition, there will be bouncy castles and inflatable slides on the school field for a small fee, adding even more fun for the children.

Pupil Performances

Parents and carers will need to return pupils to the main school yard five minutes before the start of their own scheduled performance, times are shown on the event timetable.

Performances will start exactly on time. We are unable to delay this due to the tight running schedule. Pupils will be returned to parents and carers immediately after their performances have finished.

Colour Run

Later in the day, parents and carers are also warmly invited to take part in the Colour Run. Mr Owen will call each year group, along with their accompanying adults, when it is time for them to begin. Pupils can participate in their run with or without adults.

To safeguard our pupils, no adults should enter the pupils' toilets. Adults must use the toilet block provided next to the Big Bocs Bwyd.

We look forward to sharing a wonderful day of celebration and community with all of you.

In the event of poor weather, like today, we will have to postpone the Easter Bonnet Parade and the Colour Run until after the holiday period and only the pupils will participate in the workshops and activities within the school buildings as part of an adapted timetable.
