Dear Parents / Carers,

It was great to welcome your children to school on Tuesday. All the children looked so smart in their uniforms and PE kits and thank you for kitting them out ready for the year ahead as well as supporting them in returning to school after the long summer break.

A special warm welcome to our new Year R pupils and other children who have joined throughout the school. You have all been so brave beginning your first week at Kingsclere, especially when it still feels like the summer holiday with such sunny and warm weather! We also welcome Miss Maisie Bagshaw (our new Elm Class teacher) and Miss Megan Rogers (our new Year 3 and 4 Learning Support Assistant) to the staff team. It is great to have you with us!

Our first two INSET days were very productive. On the second INSET day, staff were developing their planning, teaching and learning linked to our enquiry curriculum and foundation subjects ensuring plans are in place to support all children to achieve high quality outcomes. We have high expectations for all our children in core subjects and our foundation subjects so all children experience a high-quality well-rounded education.

Our staff team have worked hard to develop their classroom spaces and make them as welcoming as possible for the children as well as inspiring, to support children's learning and wellbeing. We have introduced a new nurture classroom (where Hazel Class used to be) and have also worked hard to ensure there is consistency across the school, providing resources to support our children's wellbeing and positive mental health such as our Zones of Regulations resources and classroom reflection spaces. Each class also created their own Class Charter this week following our Collective Worship linked to the Conventions on the Right of the Child.

Congratulations to all our Year 6 pupils who have taken on leadership roles within the school and thank you Year 6 for supporting your new Year R buddies this week. You have made the children feel welcome and supported during their lunch time. Our Year 6 leaders will be carrying out their new roles over the next half term to support younger year groups and the staff team in running aspects of school life.

Thank you to our Friends of Kingsclere Primary School (PTA) who set up tea and coffee on the playground this morning providing a chance for parents/carers to meet as well as fundraising for new school resources. There will be more tea and coffee mornings to come! Do come along to meet Kingsclere CE Primary School families.

End of Day Arrangements


