Topic 1.4 FOLLOWING JESUS

What should I already know?

- What a friend is
- What makes a good friend
- What Holy Week is
- That Holy Week precedes Easter Sunday

What will I know at the end of the unit?

- Recognise that Jesus chose friends to help him tell the good news that God loves everyone
- Give an example of quality or virtue needed in a follower of Jesus- 'What is my virtue?' 'How do I show it?'
- Say what the story of the Good Samaritan tells them about how they should live
- Recognise the story of Palm Sunday and Good Friday and know it is from the Bible
- Begin to retell in simple form the story of Palm Sunday or Good Friday
- Say what these stories from Holy Week tell us about Jesus
- Give two examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus in church during Holy Week
- Talk, wonder and ask questions about whether Holy Week has anything to say to them about sadness and friendship
- Give an answer to questions like 'Why are my friends important?'

## Key Vocabulary

disciples	people who followed and listened to Jesus
Jerusalem	The capital of Judea in Jesus' time.
Palm Sunday	The Sunday before Easter Sunday when Jesus entered Jerusalem
crucifix	a cross with the figure of Jesus crucified upon it
Good Friday	The day Jesus died
hosanna	Save us, Lord!
Easter Sunday	The day Jesus rose from the dead
Good Samaritan	The person who helped the traveller in Jesus' Parable. It is used to describe a charitable or helpful person
palms	A leaf of a palm tree used to welcome Jesus to Jerusalem
Christian	a follower of Jesus
Parable	A simple story, often used by Jesus, to explain religious truths.
Holy Week	the week leading up to Easter, and is the week during which Christians particularly remember the last week of Jesus's life.
