David Attenborough is 100!

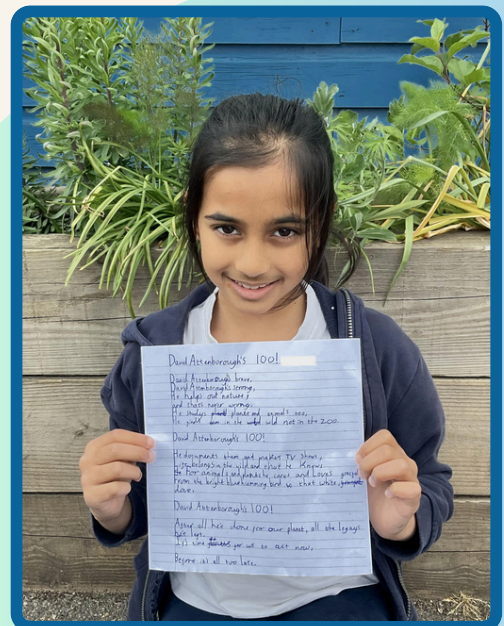
**David Attenborough's brave
