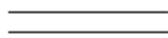


1) Which pictures show at least one angle?

2) The arrow on the spinner starts by pointing to the rectangle and makes an anticlockwise turn.

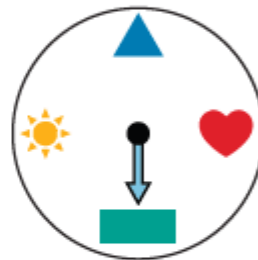
Identify the anticlockwise turn it could have made to point to each given image.

a) triangle

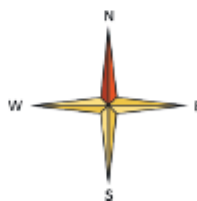
b) heart

d) a full turn anticlockwise



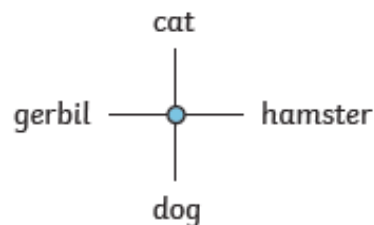

- a) Follow the instructions, writing each number you are facing after each step, to work out the code.

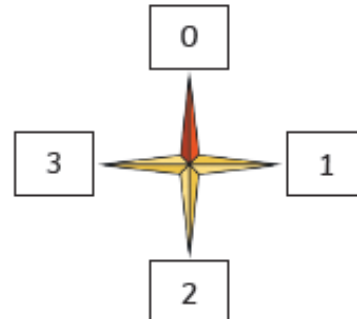
Start by facing 0.

Then, make a half turn anticlockwise.

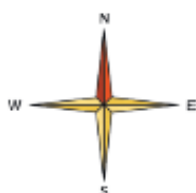
Next, make a three-quarter clockwise.
