St John the Baptist Primary School are fortunate to have a PTFA that helps support our school with social and fundraising activities.

The PTFA is a separate organisation to the school, so we have to take account of our Data Protection obligations.

The PTFA promotes its activities using social media and contacts with families. As a school, we will share those events using our school media and communication platforms.

What personal data may be shared	The Chair of the PTFA have access to your contact details in WEDUC, specifically your name, email and telephone number and the child's full name that you have Parental Responsibility for
What will it be used for?	To message you via WEDUC to communicate to you about the activities the PTFA are undertaking
How long will we keep it?	Once your child leaves the school (following working day) the information is removed from WEDUC and cannot be accessed by the Chair of the PTFA
How will we store it?	The data is stored securely on an offsite server
Will it be shared with others? If so, who?	Employees of WEDUC will have access to the information stored on their server
