<b>Ramadan</b>	The ninth month of the Islamic calendar. It is a month of fasting, prayer, reflection and community.
<b>Eid-al-Fitr</b>	Muslim festival celebrating the end of Ramadan
<b>Hanukkah</b>	Jewish festival of light commemorating the rededication of the Temple in Jerusalem.
<b>Diwali</b>	Sikh and Hindu festival of light symbolizing the spiritual victory of light over darkness, good over evil and knowledge over ignorance.
