Subject Specific Vocabulary

Festival/celebration	A special , social event celebrated by a community.
Sacred	Holy, something worthy of worship.
Diwali	Sikh and Hindu festival of light symbolising the spiritual victory of light over darkness, good over evil and knowledge over ignorance.
Psalm Sunday and Easter	Christian festival commemorating the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
Ramadan and Eid-ul-Fitr	Ramadan is a month of fasting, prayer, reflection and community, ending with the celebration of Eid ul Fitr.
Eid-al Adha	Muslim” Festival of the Sacrifice” honours the willingness of Ibrahim to sacrifice his son as an act of obedience to God.
Shabbat	Jewish peoples “Day of Rest” and religious worship.
Sukkot	Jewish celebration known as the Feast of Tabernacles or the Festival of Shelters.
Pesach	Jewish festival commemorating the exodus of the children of Israel from Egypt.

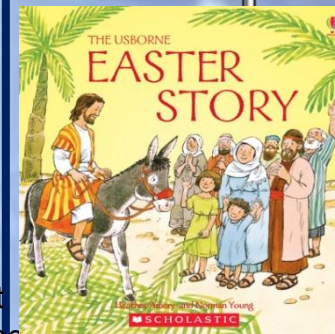
