2019 Intake

- 1 full time class for 26 eligible children
- 2 part time classes of 15 hours split into morning and afternoon sessions
- 26 places in the morning and 26 places in the afternoon



Attendance

- We do not routinely offer a flexible timetable for any of the Nursery classes.
- If you opt for a full time place your child will be expected to be in school full time for 5 days.
- The same applies for attendance on a part time basis. Your child will be expected to attend the morning session if allocated or the afternoon session if allocated



Settling in

- Pre-school children have already begun transition visits.
- All children will receive a home visit on Monday 6th or Tuesday 7th January.
- The children will then begin a phased entry (as detailed on your offer letter) on Wednesday 8th January.

The School Day

- Full-time Nursery - 8.30am - 3.15pm Monday-Friday.
- Morning Nursery - 8.30am - 11.30am Monday - Friday
- Afternoon Nursery - 12.30pm - 3.30pm Monday - Friday



The School Day

- The side gate is opened at 8.30am for both Morning and Full-time Nursery. For afternoon Nursery the gate is opened at 12.30pm.
- Parents are encouraged to come into Nursery and help their child register themselves by answering the daily question. Please feel free to stay with your child for a few minutes to settle them in or play with them in Nursery. Siblings are welcome also.
- At 8.50am/12.45pm the door will be closed and we kindly ask that any remaining parents say goodbye and leave. The register is taken at 9am/12.50pm. The side gate is closed at 9.10am/1pm. If you arrive after this time you will need to come in through the main school office and your child will receive a later mark in the register.



The School Day

- For Morning Nursery, pick up time is 11.30am. The side gate will be opened at 11.30am and closed again at 11.40am. If your child hasn't been collected by this time you will need to collect them from the main office.
- At the end of the day the side gate is opened at 3.10pm. Pick up time for Full-Time Nursery is 3.15pm. For Afternoon Nursery it is between 3.15pm and 3.30pm. If your child has not been collected by 3.30pm you will need to collect them from the main office.
- It is really important that your child attends school on time everyday. However, if your child is unwell and unable to attend Nursery, please contact the school office before 8.30am and let them know. Please do this on each day your child is absent.



Lunchtime in Full Time Nursery

- We offer lunchtime supervision in addition to the 30 hours offered to eligible families.
- However, we do not provide a meal for the children. Your child will require an appropriate packed lunch.
- You can choose to take your child home for lunch and bring them back in time for the afternoon but this can not be ad hoc.



Uniform

- Please ensure your child is always dressed for school in the appropriate school uniform. School sweatshirts and cardigans can be purchased from John McHugh and Elite Clothing.
- Could you also ensure that all uniform and belongings are labelled with your child's name.
- Trainers are NOT allowed to be worn for school. Velcro shoes would be really helpful!
