This week in Reception

Phonics:

We will be learning the phonemes: ck, e, u, r and introducing the term 'digraph' which is when 2 letters make one sound. We will practise blending sounds together to read words using previously taught letter- sounds eg pick, peg. Our 'tricky' words include: is, I, to, and, his, the, no, go.

What we are learning:

We will be continuing our topic, The World of Rhyme, focusing on the story of 'Room on the Broom.' We will be developing our fine motor skills by cutting and assembling resources to make wands. We will continue working on the correct letter formation of e, u, and r. In maths, we will look at use more specific language such as tall, long and short when making comparisons. We will study the composition of 5.

On Friday 10th October, we will finish our topic of 'The World of Rhyme' by inviting the children to come into school dressed as any character from a Julia Donaldson book or from a nursery rhyme. We look forward to the event.

Please continue to practise learning the letter- sounds s, a, t, p, i, m, n, d, g, o, c, k and as the week progresses ck, e, u and r.
