To know the multiplication and division facts for the 5 times table

Key Facts		Key Vocabulary
$5 \times 1 = 5$	$5 \div 5 = 1$	What is 5 times 5?
$5 \times 2 = 10$	$10 \div 5 = 2$	What is 5 multiplied by 7?
$5 \times 3 = 15$	$15 \div 5 = 3$	What is 8 groups of 5?
$5 \times 4 = 20$	$20 \div 5 = 4$	What is 30 divided by 5?
$5 \times 5 = 25$	$25 \div 5 = 5$	What is 45 shared between 5?
$5 \times 6 = 30$	$30 \div 5 = 6$	What is 55 divided into groups of 5?
$5 \times 7 = 35$	$35 \div 5 = 7$	
$5 \times 8 = 40$	$40 \div 5 = 8$	
$5 \times 9 = 45$	$45 \div 5 = 9$	
$5 \times 10 = 50$	$50 \div 5 = 10$	
$5 \times 11 = 55$	$55 \div 5 = 11$	
$5 \times 12 = 60$	$60 \div 5 = 12$	

They should be able to answer these in any order, including missing number questions eg $5 \times _ = 40$ or $_ \div 5 = 9$
