- Identify class targets for vocab, text structure, punctuation
- Adapt model text
- Ensure targets are set

- Learn oral text
- Shared read, understand text type
- Collect vocab, definitions, synonyms
- Check comprehension
- Explore structure and co-construct boxing up
- Analyse for effect on reader and construct toolkit
- Possibly explore similar texts in focussed reading to add to toolkit
- Short burst writing
- Text games

- Teacher models planning new text with input from class
- Bank ideas and vocab
- Each lesson teaches English curriculum skill or target, developed through shared writing of new text
- Opportunity for children to develop each skill while writing part of the new text
- Teacher evaluates each part and provides targeted input next lesson
- Children to edit & improve

- Teach/recap from innovations
- Provide stimulus for 'show what you know' task related to innovations
- Independently plan new text
- Write new text
- Use and apply toolkit and structures
- Edit & improve
