There were also free treats such as popcorn, candy floss, glitter tattoos and face painting. The entertainment was non-stop, with a DJ, live singers (including an Elton John impersonator), a brass band, cheerleaders, costumed characters, magicians, Pearly Kings and Queens, robots and even robot dogs. BREAKFAST CLUB
