# What is phonics?



# <u>Graphemes</u>

This is the word we use when we refer to letters.

e.g. snap has 4 graphemes s-n-a-p



# English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)

# English is one of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.

#### How do I use the Virtual Classroom?

- **1.** Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child each day.
- 2. Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet.
- **3.** Praise your child as they join in with the lesson make it fun!

The more they practise using these films, the quicker they'll learn to read.



# What can I do at home to help?

- 1. Use pure sounds rather than letter names.
- 2. Use Fred Talk to help your child to read and spell words.
- 3. Listen to your child read their Storybook every day.
- **4.** Watch the Virtual Classroom films together.
- 5. Read stories to your child every day.
