So what happens in Reception?

Reception starts from 8.45am and finishes at 3.15pm. This is where you will put your coat when you arrive. You will have your own peg with your picture and name on it.



We have Register time where we say good morning to each other and then we start some Phonics learning time. This picture shows some of the children sitting down in their carpet places. Aren't they sitting smartly? We will talk about the day ahead and also learn about stories and writing.



Then we can get on with doing some independent learning, you can choose whether you stay inside or play outside in our garden. There will be lots of activities in both. Grown-ups will be doing fun activities with you and helping you to learn – have a look over the page at some of the things that we do.



We will help you to learn to read and write independently. We will also learn to count and use numbers.



You will be able to explore all the different areas of our classroom, like the role play and the technology areas.



You can play in the sand/water, play with construction, explore our outdoor area and even go to the cookery room!





After we have been busy learning and exploring, we then tidy up. The grown ups will help you to learn where to put things.
