Phonics:

In Phonics, we will be reading and writing words ending in '-ing' such as groaning, creeping, sleeping and painting. We will be reading and writing words ending in '-ed' (b) such as cloaked, sparked and screeched. We will be reading and writing words ending in '-ed' (id) such as crowded, boasted. We will say the following sentence 3 times, and count the words. We will segment the sounds in the words and write the sentence using cursive letter formation: 'I am painting the moon.' We will continue spelling 'tricky' words.

Practice reading the following 'tricky' words:

have says one
today what when
come some out
so do
