Subject Specific Vocabulary

geography	Study of the Earth's surface, people, climate and products.
regions	An area, a part of a country or of the world.
geographical human features	Man made features within a region or country. E.g. Big Ben.
geographical physical features	Naturally formed features. E.g. Lake District and Loch Ness.
land use	Where a natural environment is changed into a built environment for a purpose.
settlement	A place, where people have built and established a community. E.g. towns and villages.
grid references	Numbers which define locations on a map.
key	Symbols which stand for different features on a map.

Countries are divided into different regions with similar characteristics.

England is split up into 9 regions.

The UK is characterised by mountains, lakes, urban and rural settlements with 7723 miles of coastline.

Europe is currently made up of 44 countries.

Grid references are used to locate place on a map.
