Your children have continued to do you proud and have had another fantastic week! We started our learning by reading the book, "Titch" and thought about how we grow and change over time. We then matched baby animals to their mothers and learnt words to describe young animals, for example, cub.

In maths, we have continued to compare amounts. The children have really enjoyed using the weighing scales to weigh items in the classroom. We have also started thinking about what a pattern is and how we can create a repeating pattern.

The absolute highlight of our week has been reading time with Poppy the dog! Poppy is going to come in every Monday and spend time with the children. We read Poppy the story, "Dear Zoo", as that is a story we have been looking at in Maths, thinking about sizes of animals. She really enjoyed it, and so did the children.
