Good things for your child and school





Sign up to the Pupil Premium scheme and your school could receive hundreds of pounds from the Department for Education.

In fact, for every eligible parent who signs up, the school could be in line for between £900 and £1,300 to spend on resources like extra staff, books or school trips. The total extra amount your school could receive if all eligible parents apply is tens of thousands of pounds. One of the added extras of this scheme is the opportunity for your child to receive free nutritious meals at school; which research has shown links to educational attainment.

Is your child eligible for the Pupil Premium scheme?

In order for Lovelace Primary School to check if your school can claim the **Pupil Premium** for your child, they need your help. Just complete the simple form below and hand it back completed to the school office who will process your application via the local authority website. The website will only show whether or not a child is eligible for the scheme. It does not give any information about you or your child.

What happens if my child is eligible for the Pupil Premium scheme?

The school will look after everything. They will ask if you would like your child to receive free meals at school and the **Pupil Premium** funding will automatically be passed to them. The school will be able to tell you how the extra money is being used.

What happens if my child isn't eligible for the Pupil Premium scheme?

The **Pupil Premium** scheme's fundamental aim is to enhance students learning and to assist financially when required. Even if your child is not eligible for the scheme right now, circumstances may change during the 12 years they are at school and they may need some support in later years. If you apply for the scheme now, Lovelace Primary School can check your child's eligibility right through their education so if your circumstances change, the school can take care of everything.

Do I need to apply for Pupil Premium if my child already receives free meals at school?

Yes please. Although children in YR-Y2 are currently eligible for the free school meals at school, we can't check the child's eligibility for the full **Pupil Premium** scheme unless they have the details included on the form below.

How will the school use the extra money?

Each school may use the funding slightly differently and will publish what they do on their website. Some examples of how we are currently using the money include the following:

- Introducing reading and homework clubs.
- Subsidising the cost of residential school trips and swimming lessons.
- Paying for additional staffing.
- Providing for small intervention groups.
- Providing a wide range of extra-curricular activities.
