The questions allow you to add a comment so that we can continue to work together to celebrate successes as well as find ways to improve and to address concerns. ERB Enhanced Resource Base

ERBs are the latest attempt to support the increasing needs of pupils with SEND. There are 413 pupils awaiting specialist provision across Leicestershire and the local authority are creating ERB classrooms to support these children who require specialist support. At Belvoirdale, we have pupils who have different needs and we will always develop our own strategies to support for as long as we can.
