Early Years

In Geography, we talked about why it is helpful to watch a weather forecast to plan your day. We learnt the different countries in the UK because the weather is not the same everywhere and there are some patterns to this. It is usually colder in Scotland and Northern Ireland and warmer in England and Wales. The more northern countries are colder, and the more southern countries are warmer. We talked about how the forecast uses weather patterns to predict what might happen and that these can be daily or seasonal.

Our Year One and Early Years geographers scripted and performed their own weather forecasts.
