



If you missed the newsletter on Friday 12th November, please do take a look at some of the activities that took place in school to support Remembrance Day 2021.



School Attendance—Ongoing Reporting.

The information below shows that whole school attendance for the dates between 6th September and 26th November 2021 is currently **92.3%**, down 0.4% from a fortnight ago, which is below the expected attendance rate of **96% or higher**.
