

Language Angels uses slides (usually PowerPoint-style presentations) as a key part of teaching Spanish to children, especially in primary schools. These slides are designed to be **visual, interactive, and repetitive**, which helps young learners remember new vocabulary and phrases more easily.



How the slides help children learn Spanish

1. Visuals to aid memory and learning

- Each slide often includes **pictures or illustrations** alongside Spanish words.
- For example, a picture of a mother with the word "*la madre*" helps children connect meaning quickly.

In order to give pupils the best opportunity to improve their language skills, the Coppice Primary subscribes yearly to Language Angels.

2. Repetition and pronunciation

- Slides are used to **repeat words and phrases** several times.
- Teachers (or audio in the slides) model pronunciation, and children repeat.

3. Step-by-step progression

- Lessons build gradually:
 - First: single words (*madre, padre*)
 - Then: phrases (*mi madre*)
 - Finally: full sentences (*Mi madre se llama Ana*)

4. Interactive activities

- Slides often include:
 - "Repeat after me"
 - Matching games
 - Quick quizzes
- This keeps students engaged rather than just listening.

5. Consistent structure

- Each lesson follows a similar pattern, so children feel confident and know what to expect.



Example slide: *La familia* (The Family)

Here's a simple example of what a slide might look like:

Slide Title: *La familia*

👤 el padre
(picture of a father)

👩 la madre
(picture of a mother)

👦 el hermano
(picture of a brother)

👧 la hermana
(picture of a sister)

🗣️ Practice section:

Repeat after me:

- el padre
- la madre
- el hermano
- la hermana



Challenge:

¿Cómo se dice “my mother” en español?

👉 *Mi madre*

★ Extension (next slide idea):

Mi familia:

- *Mi padre se llama Carlos*
- *Mi madre se llama Ana*

This kind of slide works well because it's clear, colourful, and focused on just a few words at a time, which is ideal for children learning a new language.
