

Our Theme for the Summer Term is:



RE

This term the children will be studying the topics 'From Easter to Pentecost' and 'The Kingdom of God'.

English

We are looking at re telling and re-inventing stories using texts such as Billy and the Dragon and Billy and the Beast.

We will also focus on improving the children's spoken language in a variety of ways.

Phonics – We will be focussing on alternative pronunciations and the Phonics Screening Check. We will also be continuing to improve recognition of the high frequency and common exception words to help with word reading.

Comprehension- As well as improving word reading, talking more about the books we have read is so important.

Writing:

Recounts, story maps, role-play, hot-seating, questions, time connectives, using 'and' and 'because', writing at length

In our **handwriting** sessions we are focussing on our posture and grip as well as how we form letters cursively.

We will be continuing to write our sentences using our targets (leaving spaces, using joining words, punctuating them correctly etc.)

Maths

- Understand multiplication as 'lots of' and division as sharing
- Use the symbols x and divide correctly
- Begin to recall multiplication and division facts for the 2,5,10 multiplication tables
- Place value within 100
- Begin to understand fraction as part of a whole
- Write simple fractions
- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes
- Position and direction
- Recognise and know the value of different combinations of coins and notes
- Measure and begin to understand how we tell the time
