**Dear Parents and Carers,**

On Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June, all year 5/6 classes have taken part in a Zoom lesson with Primary Futures and Maritime UK. We learnt about 3 different jobs, what their jobs entail and the skills needed if we were interested in a similar career. Their job roles included engineering, laws and regulations involved in shipping in the UK, using new technology in shipping (including driverless boats) and the life of a deck officer, keeping people on board ships safe and planning where they sail.

It was very interesting and we had to guess who held which job and were able to ask them questions about their work.

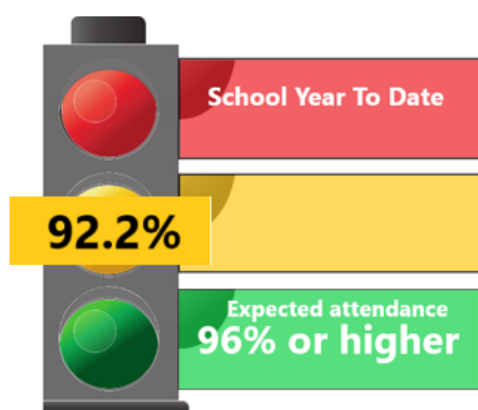
If you are a family who meet the following criteria:

- You are a family (at least 2 people where at least 1 person is either pre-birth or up to 18 years old.)
- You are experiencing financial hardship.
- You need financial help to pay utility bills or buy food and essential items linked to food, warmth, and utilities for your family.
- Not have received financial assistance from another source for the same reason.

Until September you may be able to access a small grant through Early Help to support with food, energy and water bills for household purposes, essential white goods such as a fridge, freezer, or cookers and consideration for petrol for essential journeys.
