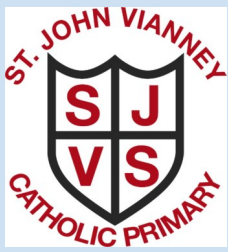

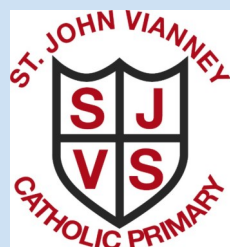

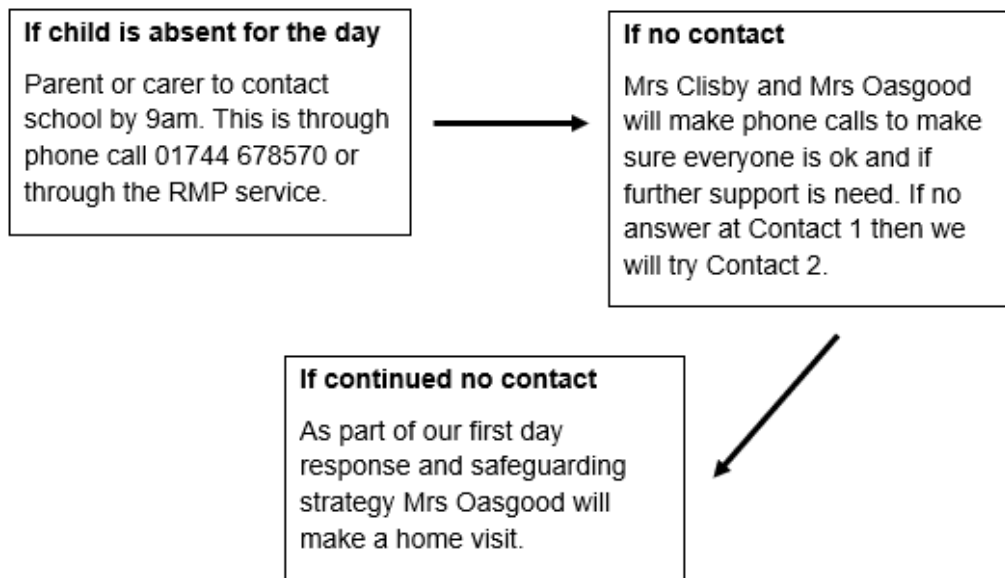

A reminder of our procedure when your child is absent

Please be aware that if your child's attendance falls below 92% they are at risk of becoming a persistent absentee and school will have a meeting with you to discuss this concern. If your child's attendance falls below 90%, they are classed as being a persistent absentee. In these cases school will take advice from the Education Welfare Service. We would try and ensure that we work with you to resolve any problems that may attribute to non-attendance/lateness before taking this last line of action.

Guide to criteria for non-attendance leading to a penalty notice possibly being given.

- 10 sessions (5 school days) of unauthorised absence, including unauthorised holiday, during a period of 10 school weeks. The absences do not need to be consecutive.
