<p>Locational knowledge</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Locate the countries of South America focusing on environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics and major cities.
<p>Place knowledge</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of the human and physical geography of a region of the UK and a region in South America.
<p>Human and Physical Geography</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography including, vegetation belts, biomes and tectonic plates. ● Describe and understand key aspects of human geography including, distribution of natural resources e.g. energy, food, minerals and water.
<p>Geographical skills and fieldwork</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Communicate findings in the most appropriate ways for each student, including explaining diagrams through annotation. ● Recognise most point, line, and area symbols on OS maps using six figure grid references. ● Begin to use 16 compass points to describe route, direction and location with degrees on the compass. ● Describe route and direction using compass points and degrees. ● Consistently show understanding of pattern, movement and change through detailed fieldwork sketches.
