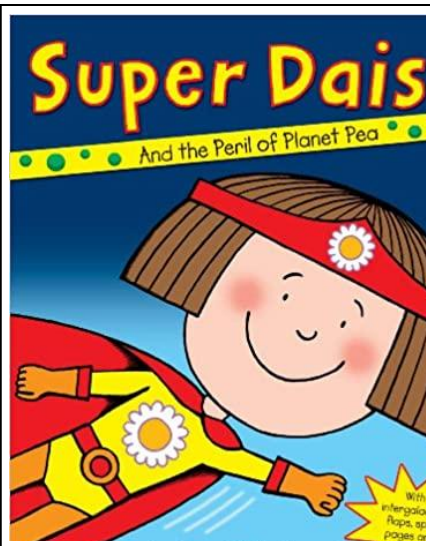


This week in Reception

Phonics:

In Phonics we will be continuing to revisit all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs - ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air. We will be reading longer words - lightning, vanish, mammoth, earring. We will be reading words when the 's' makes the 'z' sound such as visit, queens, chairs, chains, poison. We will be reading words when the 'es' makes the 'z' sound such as torches, fishes, wishes, foxes, boxes, fizzes.

We will be spelling vanish, mammoth, my, visit, poison, are, coats, cooks, sure, wishes, boxes, pure, fizzes, fishes.



Week beginning 16.3.26

What we are learning:

In Literacy, we will be sharing the story of 'Super Daisy' and looking at action words. We will be composing simple sentences such as 'She is quick and strong.' We will say the sentence three times, count the words and segment sounds to spell them. We will be identifying any digraphs.

In maths, we will be counting forwards and backwards within 20 and beginning to look at half of a number by sharing a number in 2 equal groups. In mastering number, we will be continuing to use our subitising skills and we will be using children's growing understanding of doubles to support their subitising skills.

At home

Practise doubling numbers within 10 and then finding half a number by splitting it into two equal groups.

Practise the pencil grip rhyme and have a go at using cursive letters to write the following sentence:

The cow is black.

Make a list of all the qualities a real - life superhero shows.

- Helpful
- Kind
- Caring
- Determined

And finally:

As we come to the end of our learning about Protective Behaviours, we remind the children that 'we all have the right to feel safe all of the time.'
